PRE-RACE INFORMATION

Here's everything you need to know ahead of race day, Sunday 14th June 2026.

REGISTRATION

Registration will take place at Leadout Clubhouse which is located at 18A Northend, Bedale, DL8 1AB, close to the start/finish area.



PRE-REGISTRATION

To avoid race day queues & have a more chilled out beginning to your race morning, we have pre-registration available to collect your race number and t-shirt:

Saturday 13th June, at Leadout Clubhouse between 2pm and 5pm

Leadout will be open for coffee and cake during registration – ideal for a last-minute bit of carb-loading!

RACE DAY

Please ensure that you arrive in good time to collect your race number and t-shirt.

You can collect your race number from Leadout Clubhouse from 8am through to 9:30am.

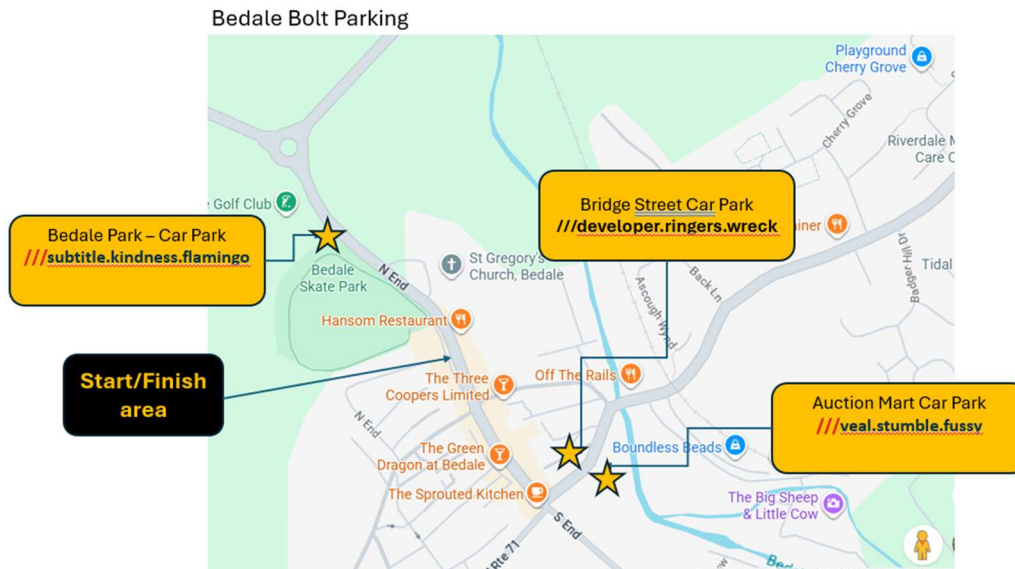
Leadout will be open for coffee for those needing a pre-race caffeine fix!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

PARKING

- There are several options available for parking on the day, parking will be available at Bedale Park, and marshals will be on hand to guide you to a space. We are recommending you use this car park if you approach from the bypass (A684) due to road closures along High Street.
- Additionally, Bedale has two car parks which are free to park on a Sunday.
- Please note, there will be no parking available along the High Street as this will be part of the race route and the market.

- If you do decide to park in residential areas, please park considerately and respect our local residents.
- A map with What-3-Words references for the car parks are below:



THE COURSE

- Is all run on road
- The majority of the course is on closed roads. If there is a section with traffic, ensure you follow the marshal's instructions
- There is a time limit of 1 hour 45 mins due to road closure restrictions. If you find you are not going to meet this time, marshals will provide guidance to enable you to complete the route.
- Noise cancelling headphones are NOT permitted.
- Bone Conducting headphones may be used at your own risk. We recommend that the volume is kept to a level that you can always hear instructions from marshals.

WEATHER

We are not currently expecting the same scorching conditions of the recent bank holiday, however, please come prepared for a warm race.

We recommend:

- Put suncream on in advance of the race
- Keep hydrated – make sure you bring extra water with you. We have a water station on course and water at the end of the race for all participants
- Hats, visors, sunglasses – have them available if you think you may need them

TOILETS

Toilets will be available close to Bedale Park in addition to the public toilets both in the park and near Bridge Street Car Park.

OTHER INFORMATION

Awards will be presented around 11:30am outside Hansom Restaurant which is just up from the start/finish area. We have prizes for overall winners and podium places for both men and women along with age grade awards. Stick around and celebrate!

It would be great to see a crowd along the start/finish line – bring family and friends along to support what we hope will be a fabulous morning!

Spectators will have the benefit of a lovely local market being on, along the High Street run by Real Markets, one of our sponsors.

There will be plenty of cafes open for refreshments while the race is underway and plenty of opportunity for a post-race cold drink and food afterwards.
